STATISTICAL SERIES ON POPULATION GROWTH  
IN PAKISTAN: PGE BASE POPULATION STATISTICS 1964-65

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This is the third of a series of reports containing the demographic statistics collected during the last two years (viz. 1964 and 1965) of the Population Growth Estimation (PGE) Project. In PGE, information about vital events was collected through two independent systems of data collection: the registration system (LR) and the enumeration system (CS)<sup>1</sup>, while the base population statistics were collected only through the CS system. Between 1962 and 1965, four CS enumeration visits were undertaken each year, followed by a final enumeration visit in January 1966. It can be seen from Table A that visits 1.0, 2.1, 3.1 and 4.1 (marked

with an asterisk) were the full enumeration visits, while the remaining 13 were the fill up visits. During the full enumeration visits, the enumerators were asked to collect information about age, sex, marital status, occupation etc., of all persons reported as usual members of the households (whether present or absent) along with visitors, guests, servants etc., who were present at the time of enumeration [37]. In the full enumeration visits the enumerators had no record of the responses in the previous fill up visits. During the fill up visits, the enumerators were asked to verify the information about household composition collected in the preceding full enumeration visit and to records changes or discrepancies therein. As regards the age reports the enumerators were told to ignore discrepancies of less than 3 years between the full enumeration and the fill up visits.

Since the information about age was collected in the full enumeration visits <sup>2</sup> (starting in April), the reported age distributions had to be adjusted for the 3 months' time lag between the full enumeration visits and the mid year time reference. For this purpose the following two types of adjustments were made:

- (1) the infants reported as 9 to 11 months old in the full enumeration visits were added to the 1 year age category. This resulted in inflating the 1 year age category to 15 months, and
- (2) one fourth of the population aged 1 year (prior to the first adjustment) was added to the 2 year category. This was repeated for ages 2,3,4 and 5. In case of the quinquennial age groups, one fourth of the population aged 9, 14, 19,....(i.e. the last age of the group) was added to the next age group.

In 1964 the first adjustment was made during the coding of the age reports. Thus, it was not possible to ascertain the number of children aged 1 year prior to the first adjustment. However, in 1965 since no adjustments were made during the coding we were able to compute the proportions (separately for males and females) of infants aged 9 to 11 months as reported in the full enumeration

visit 4.1. These proportions were applied to the 1 year age category of 1964 to estimate the number of male and female children of age 1 year prior to the first adjustment and further adjustments were made as described in the preceding paragraph.

The defacto<sup>3</sup> base population statistics for each sample area were multiplied by appropriate raising factors to arrive at the provincial and national estimates.<sup>4</sup> In this report these estimates have been presented according to the age, sex, marital status and religion.<sup>5</sup> Tables PC 3 and PC 6 give the age-sex distributions after the first adjustment while Tables PC 9 give the same after both the first and second adjustments. The age data presented in all other tables were not adjusted at all. It may be noted that the tables presented in this report have been numbered according to the system used in PGE.

A usual resident of PGE area who was present at the time of enumeration and visitors, guests etc., who spent the night prior to the interview in the PGE area were included in the defacto population. However, in 1965 information was also collected on dejure basis, that is, all persons were counted at their place of usual residence, irrespective of whether they were present or absent at the time of enumeration. The estimated number of 1965 CS dejure population was 100,192,000 for Pakistan, of which 56,573,000 persons were in East and 43,619,000 in West Pakistan.
