This is the first of a series of three reports containing the demographic statistics collected during the last two years (viz. 1964 and 1965) of the Population Growth Estimation (PGE) Project. In PGE, information about defacto¹ vital events was collected through two independent systems of data collection: the registration system (LR) and the enumeration system (CS)². Vital events statistics collected through these two system were matched and the data were adjusted, by using the Chandra-Deming³ technique, to account for events missed by both the systems of data collection. The LR, CS and the adjusted (called as Chandra-Deming) events reported from each sample area were multiplied by appropriate raising factors to arrive at the provincial and national estimates.⁴

1. A birth which occurred inside the PGE sample area (whether to a usual or nonusual resident) was counted as defacto birth. However, in 1965 information about births was also collected on dejure basis, that is, births were counted at the place of usual residence of the mother, irrespective of the place of occurrence. This approach was only used in the CS enumeration system. The estimated number of 1965 CS dejure births was 3,937,000 for Pakistan, of which 2,214,000 were in East and 1,723,000 were in West Pakistan.

3. Matching of the LR and CS vital events resulted in the following three categories:
 - a) events caught by both the LR and CS systems,
 - b) events caught by the LR but not the CS system, and
 - c) events caught by the CS but not the LR system.From these three categories of events the fourth category viz. events missed by both the LR and CS systems, was estimated by dividing the product of categories (b) and (c) with category (a). This technique was developed by Chandrasekaran and Deming [2]. For methodological details of matching operations see [4].
4. For details of estimation procedures used in PGE see [5].

In this report the 1964-1965 birth statistics have been presented according to the month of occurrence of birth, parity, age of mother, sex of the baby, religion of the father (only for 1965 East Pakistan birth statistics) and the type of estimates, that is, the registration, enumeration and the Chandra-Deming estimates. It may be noted that the tables presented in this report have been numbered according to the system used in PGE.
