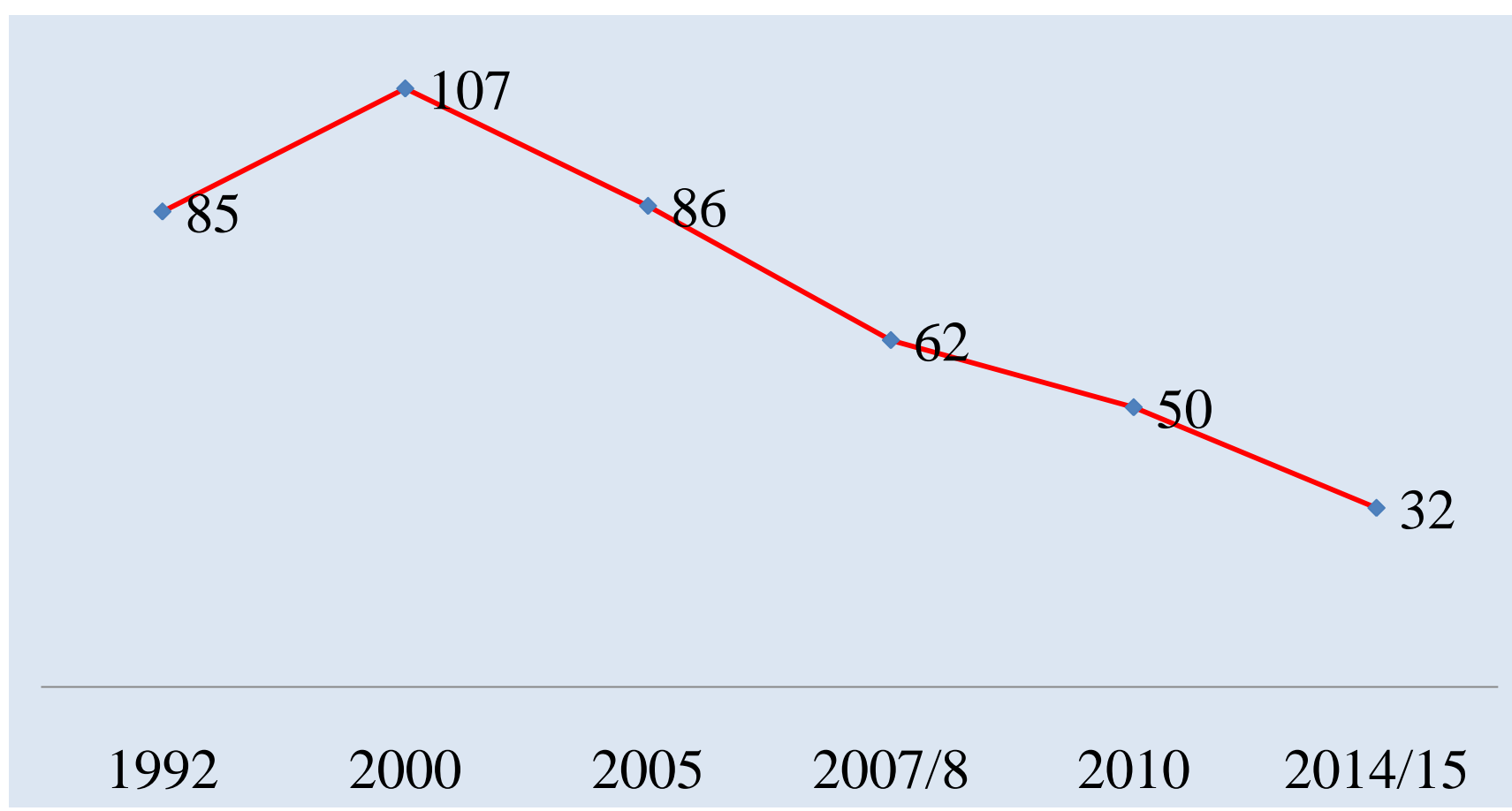

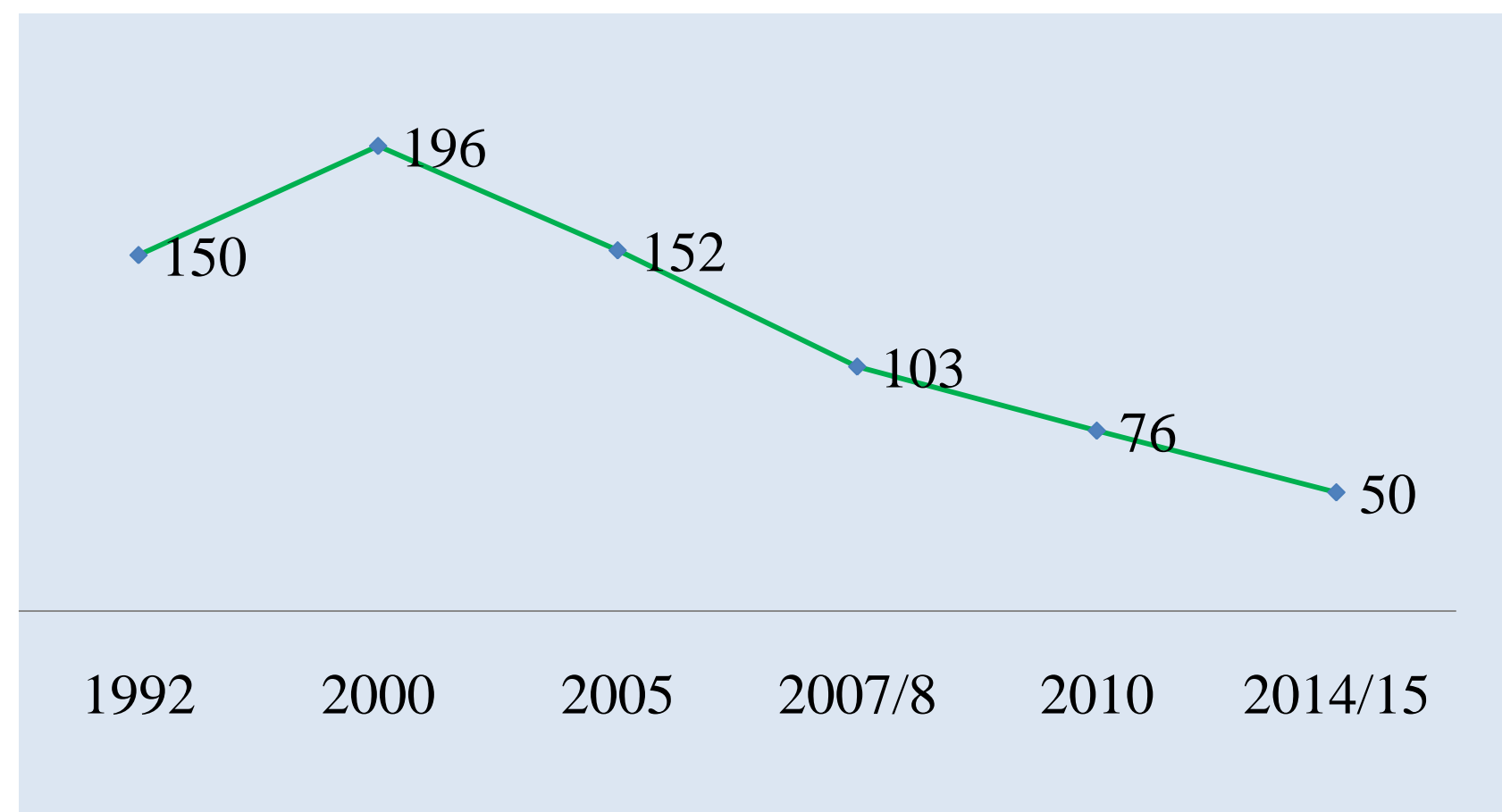

Infant Mortality Rate per 1000 Live Births 1992-2015



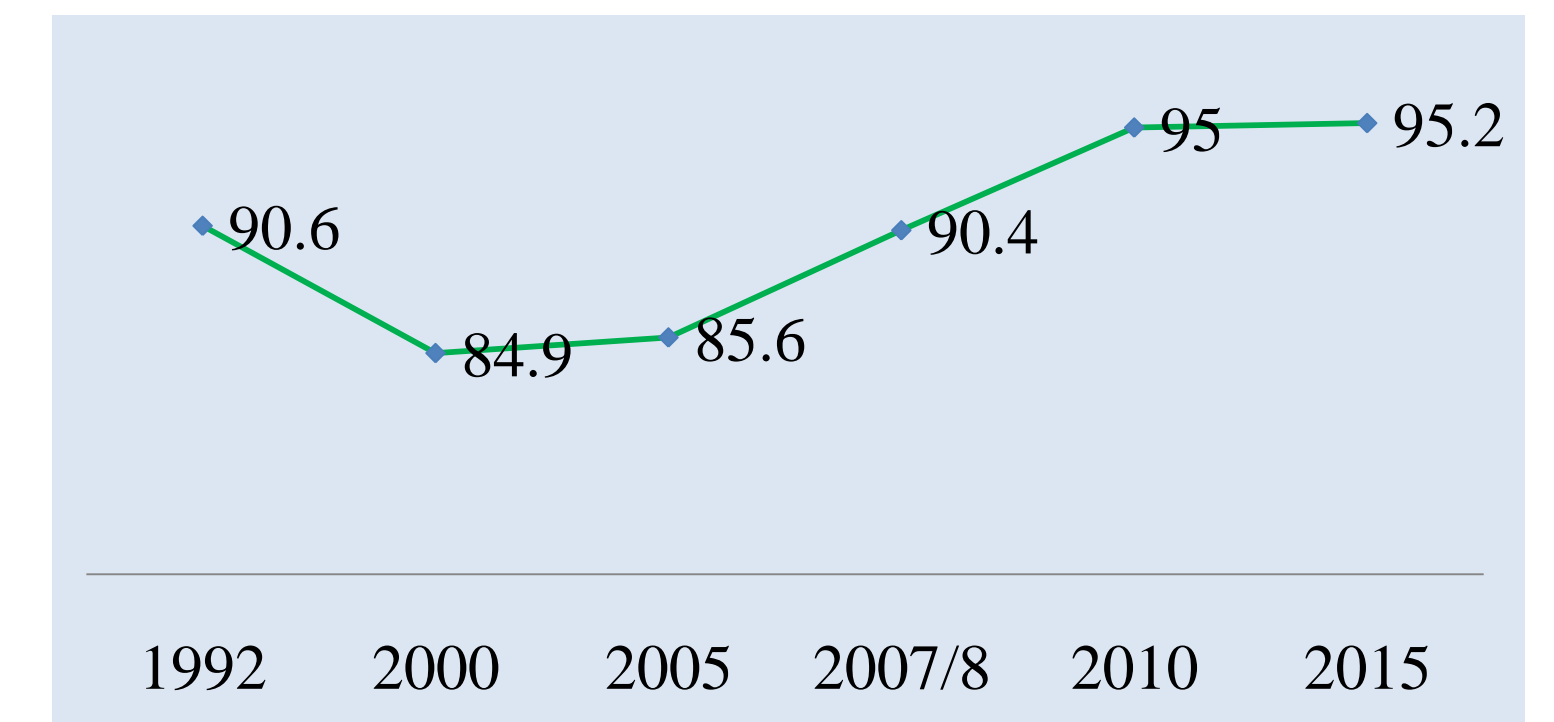

Under-5-Years Mortality Rate per 1000 Live Births 1992-2015



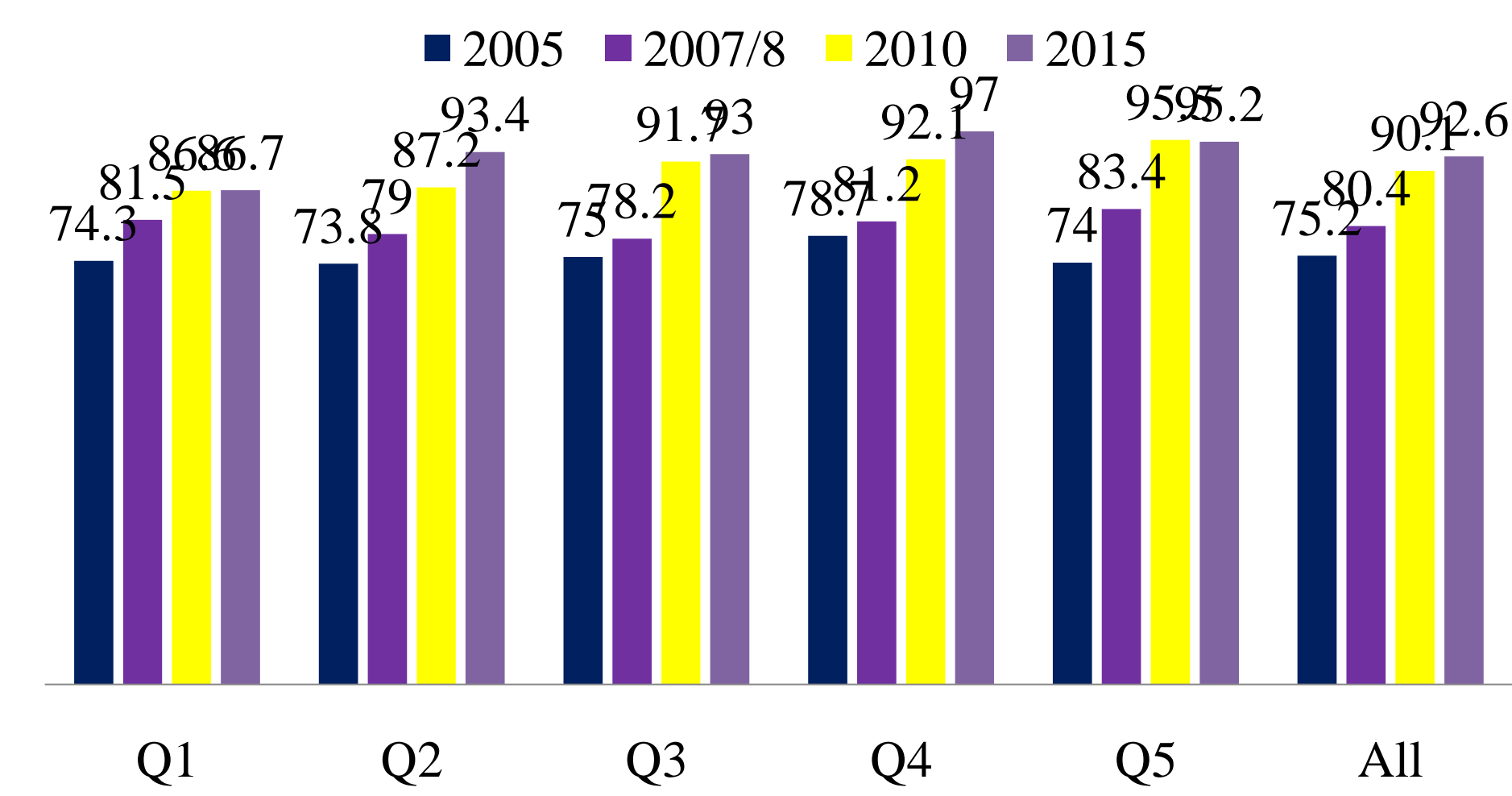

Proportion of Children 12-23 Months Immunised Against Measles 1992-2015



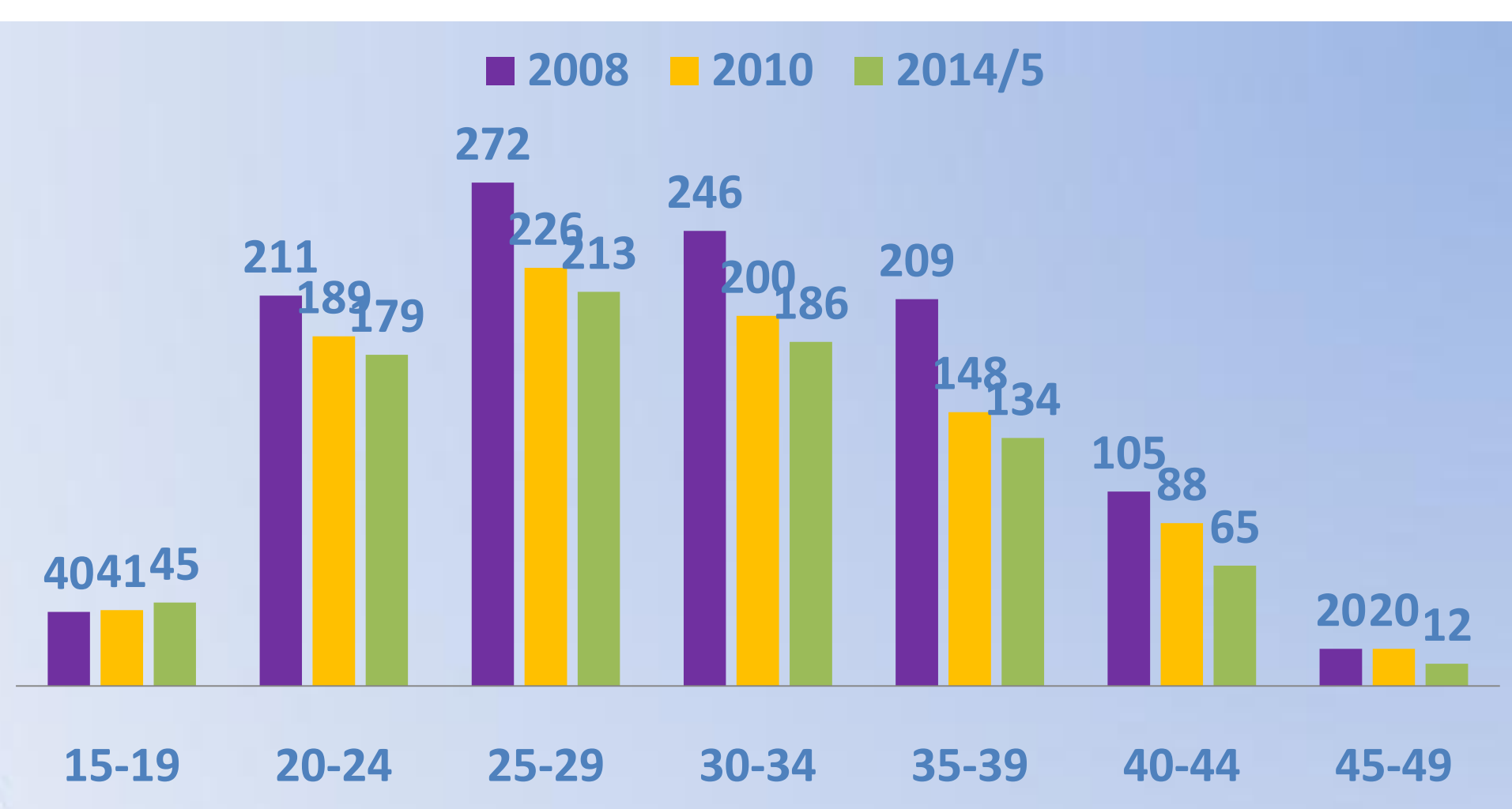

Proportion of Children Age 12-23 (18-29) months with All-Basic Vaccinations by Wealth Quintiles 2005-2014/5



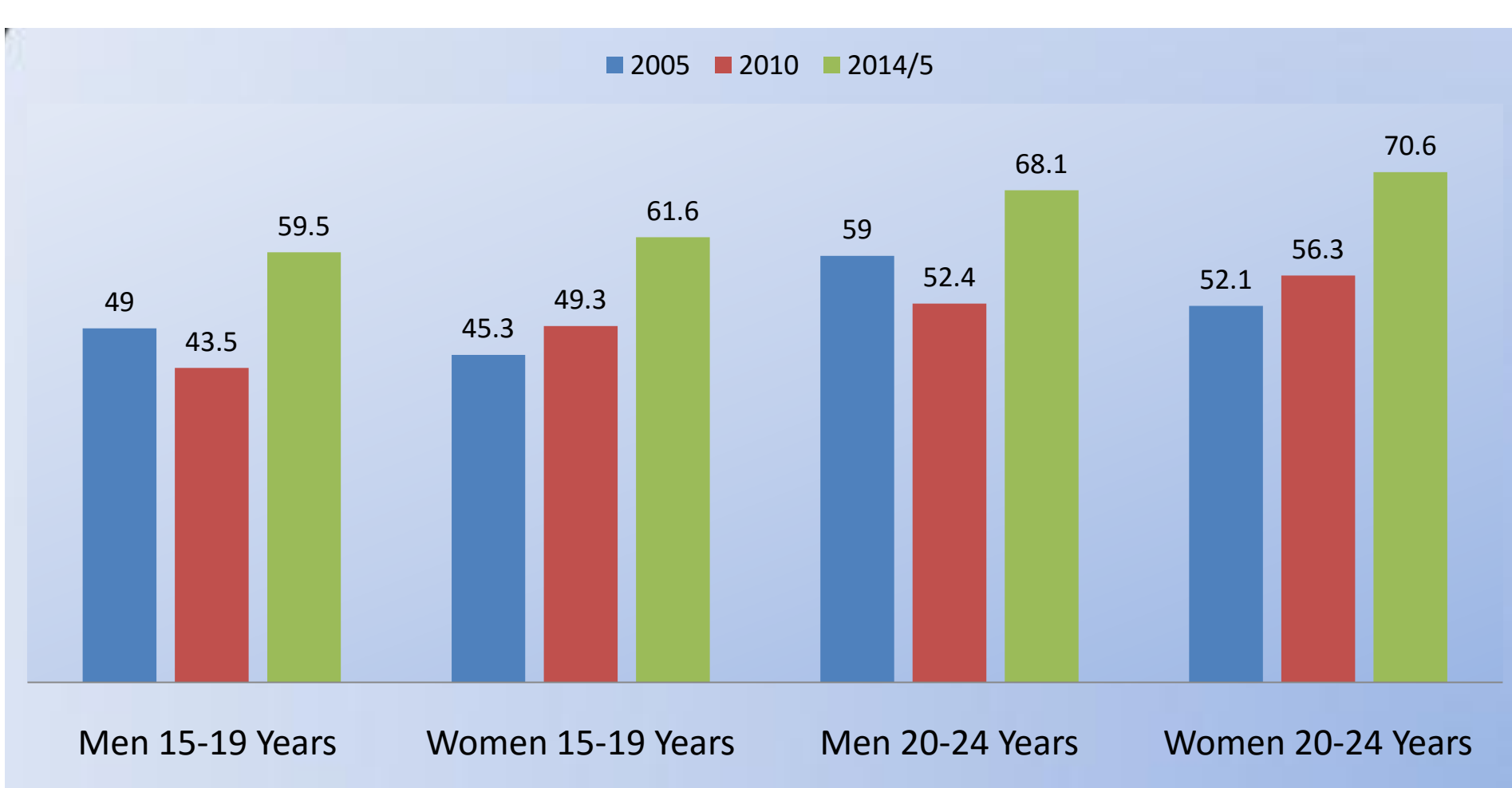

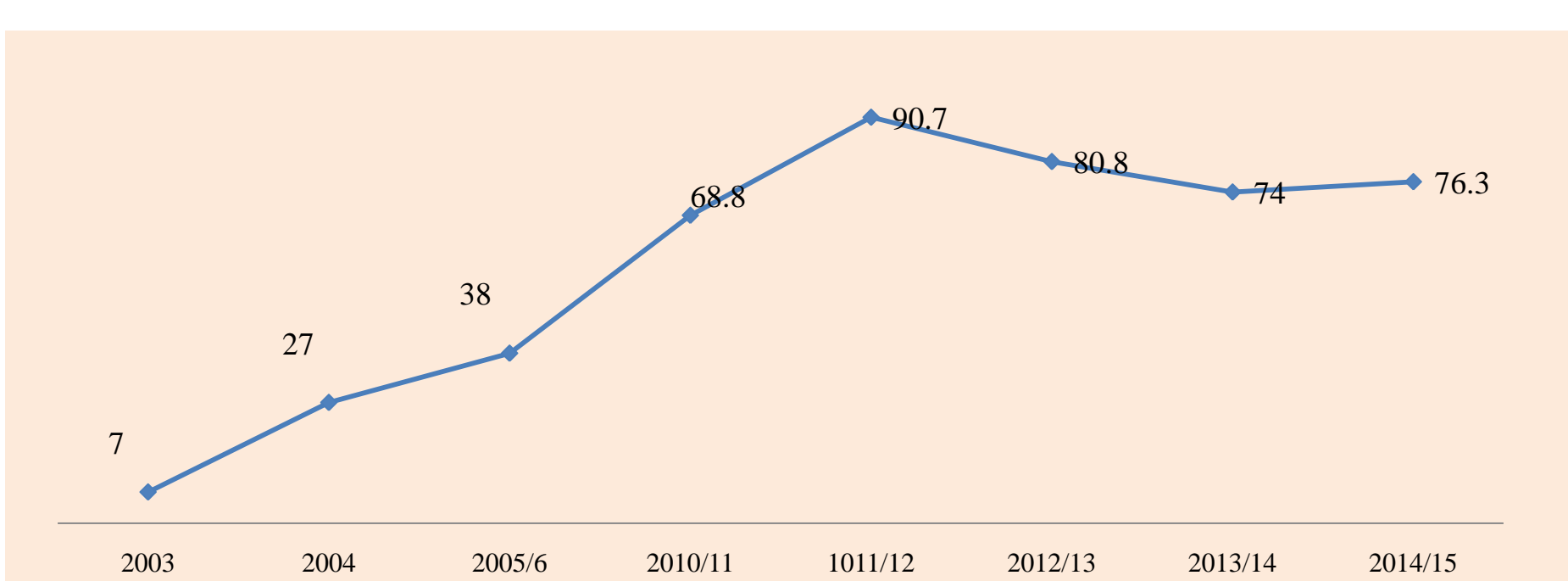
Comprehensive Knowledge about HIV, among Male and Female Youth Aged 15-24 Years, 2005-2014/5

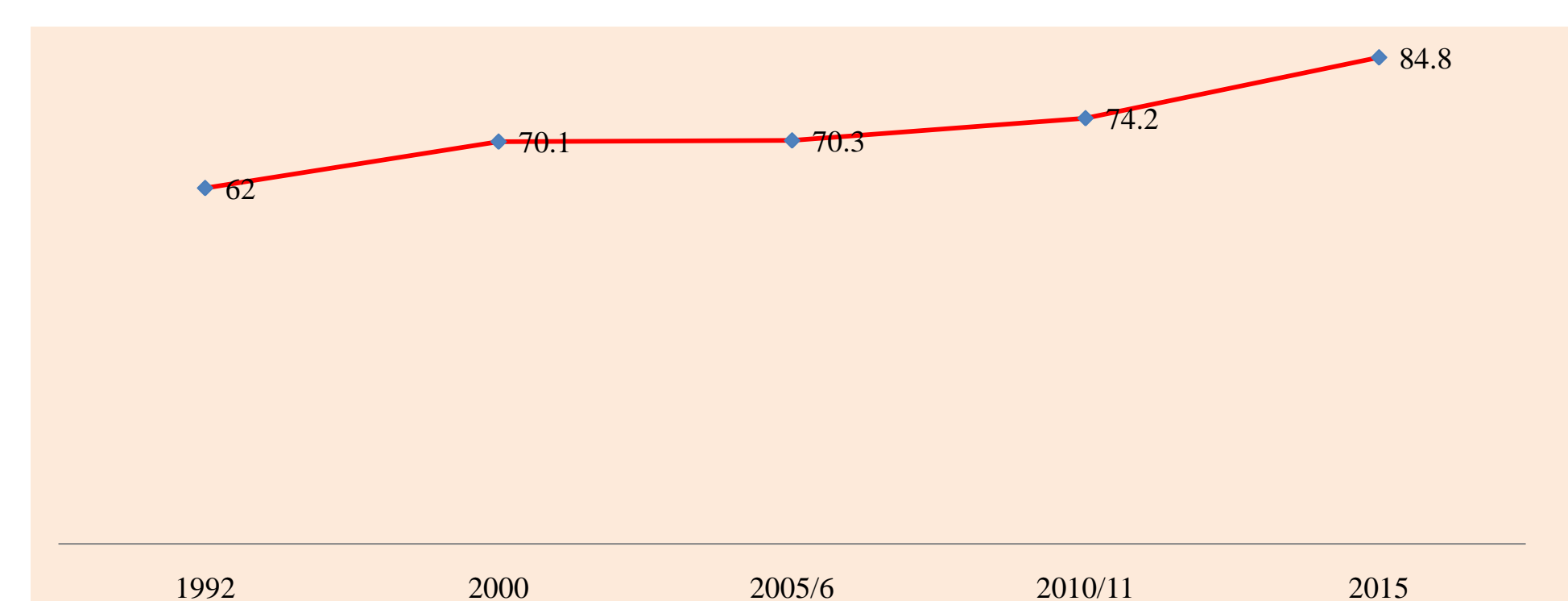

Population Covered by Mutual Health Insurance (%)



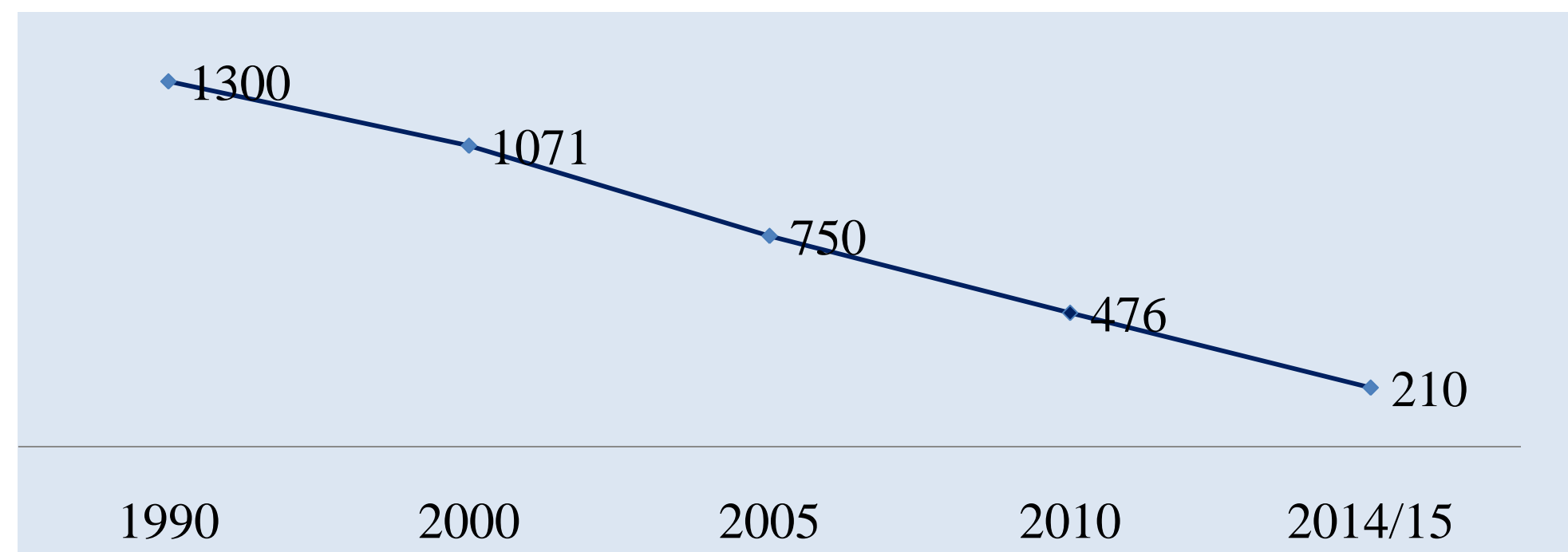

Access to Safe Drinking Water 1990-2010/11 and Linear Progression



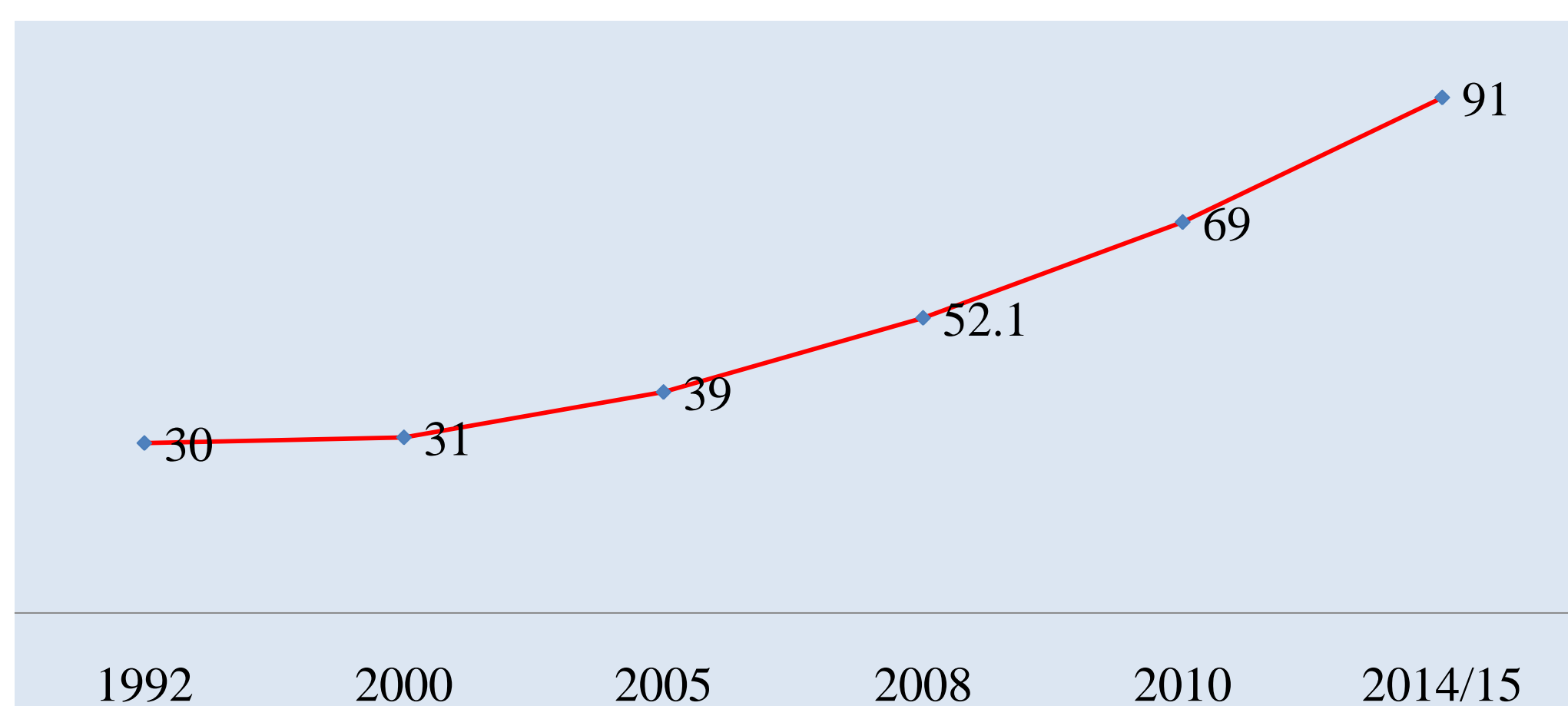

Maternal Mortality Rate per 100,000 births



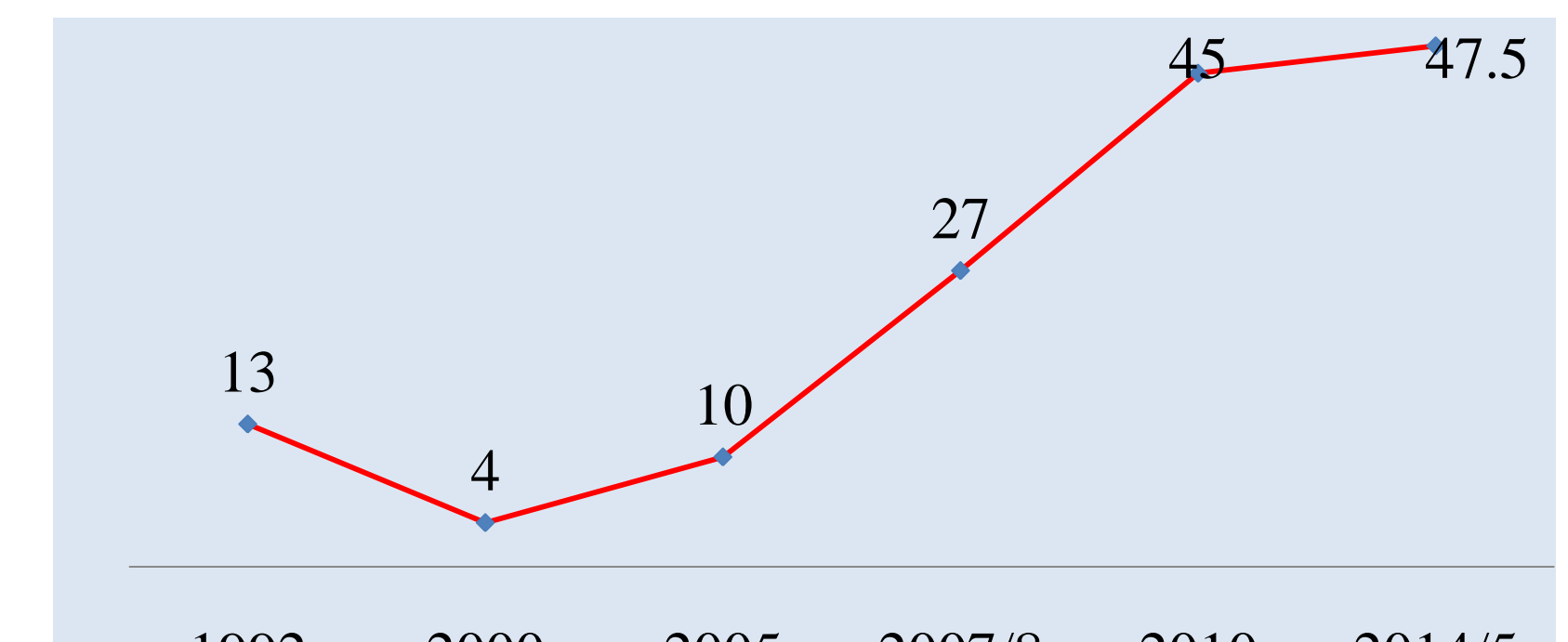

Percentage of Deliveries Assisted by a Skilled Worker 1992-2014/15

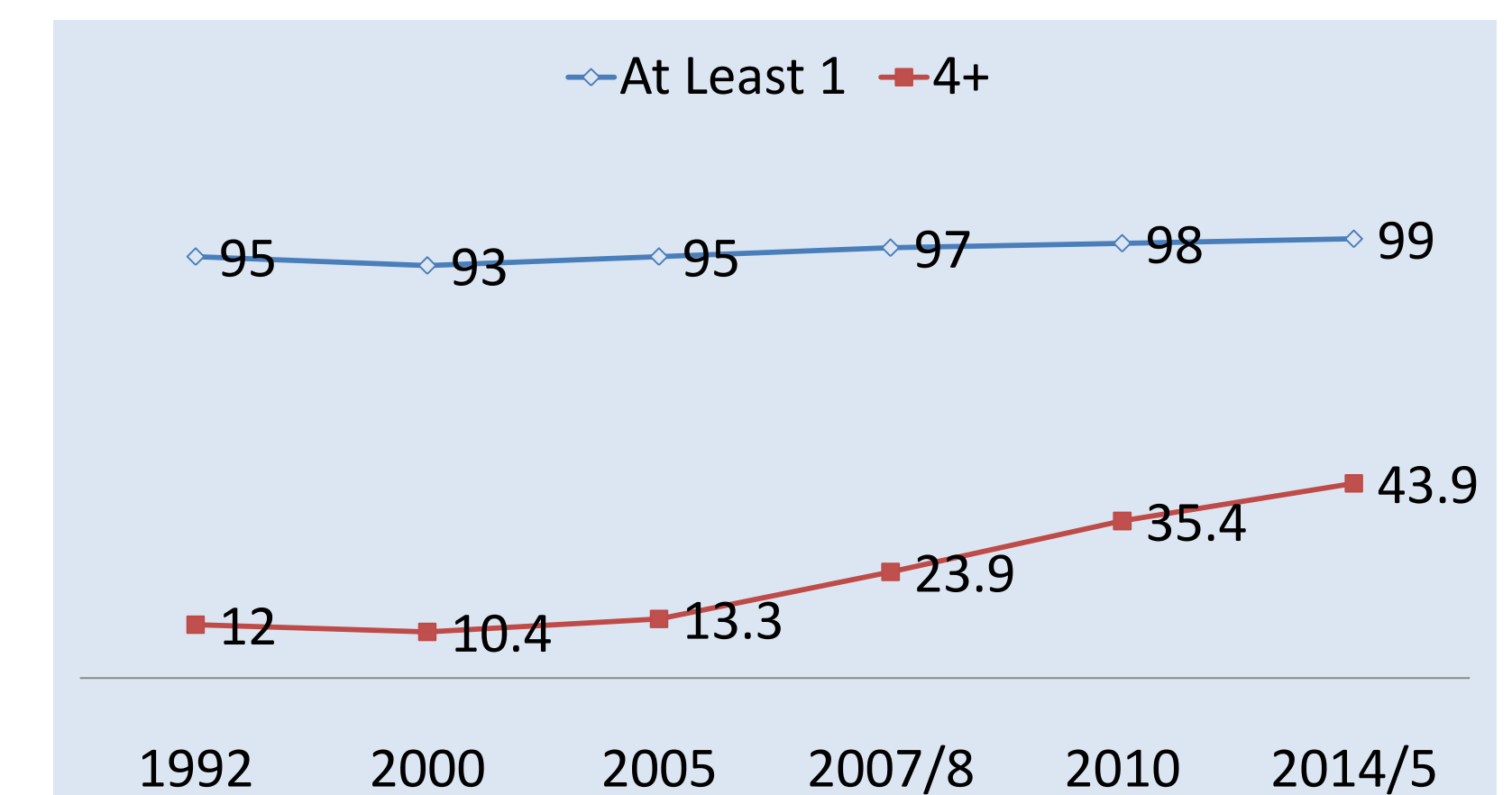

Married Women Aged 15-49 Years Uptake of Modern Contraception, 1992-2014/15



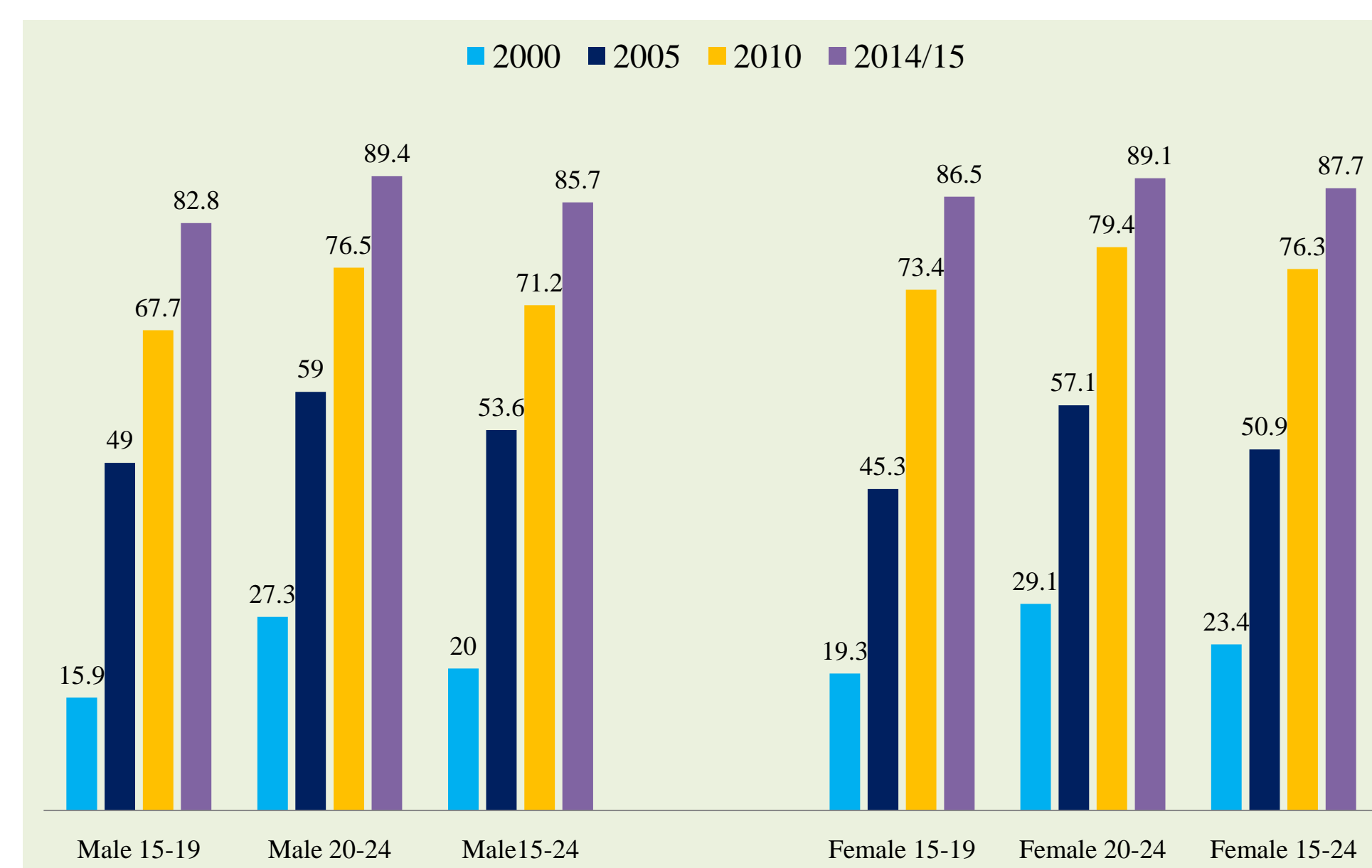
Antenatal Care Visits 1992-2015, % at least 1 visit and 4+ Visits

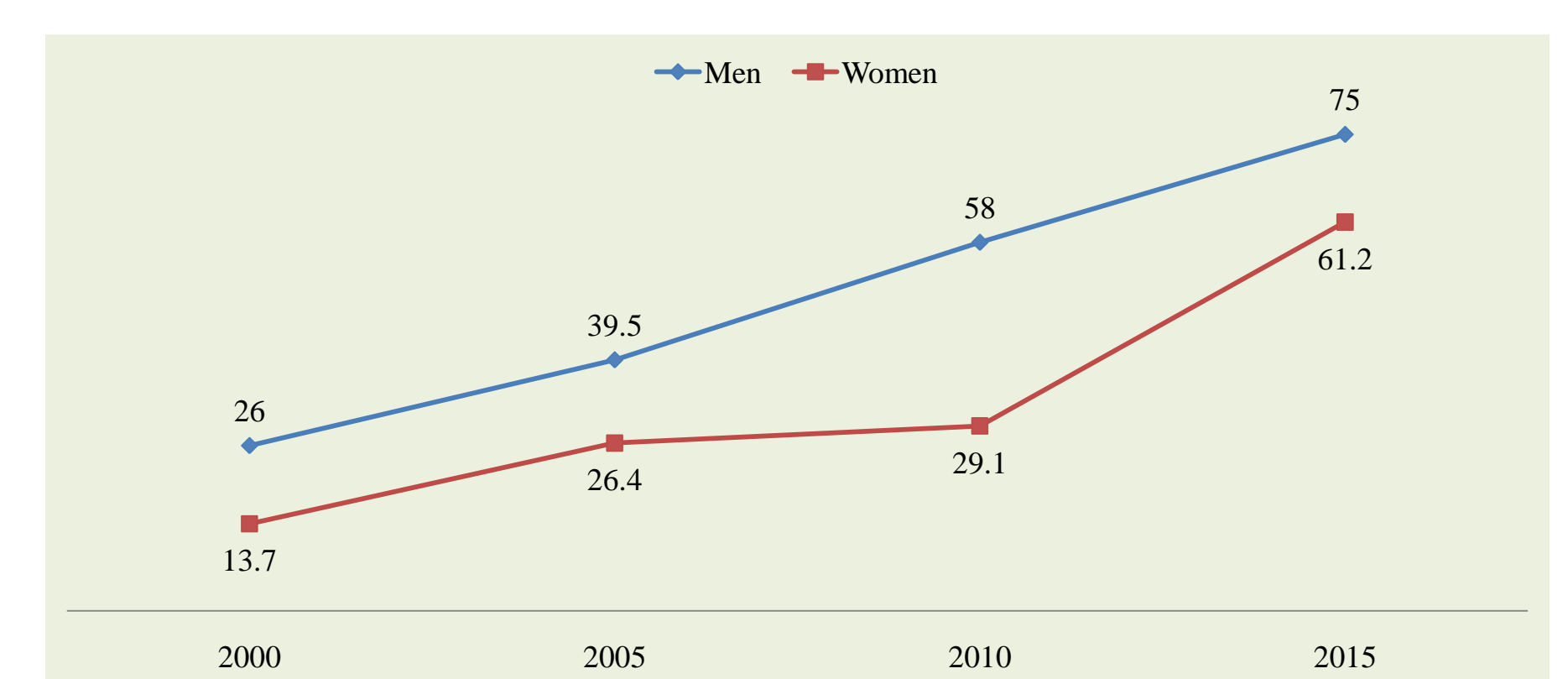

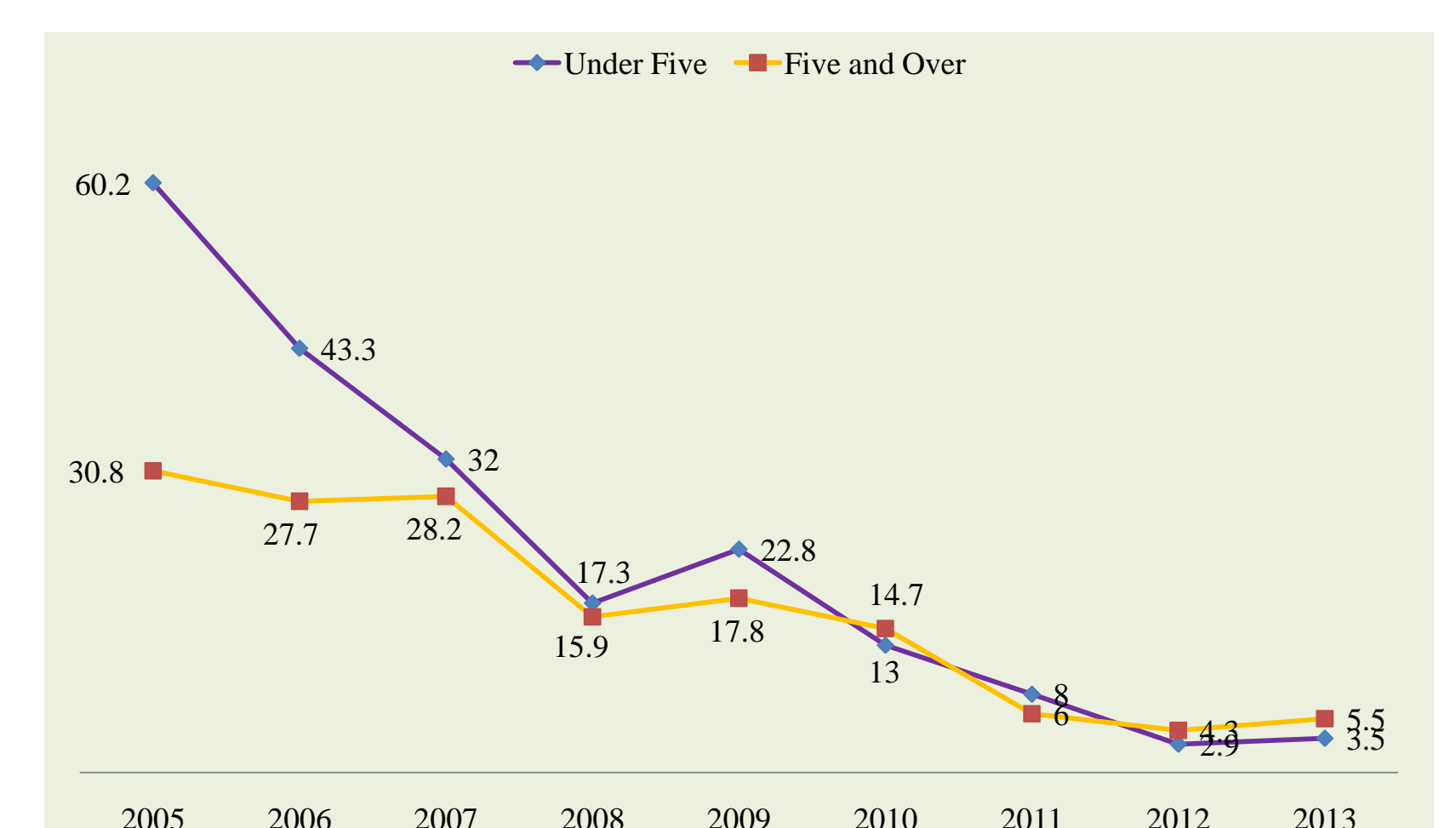

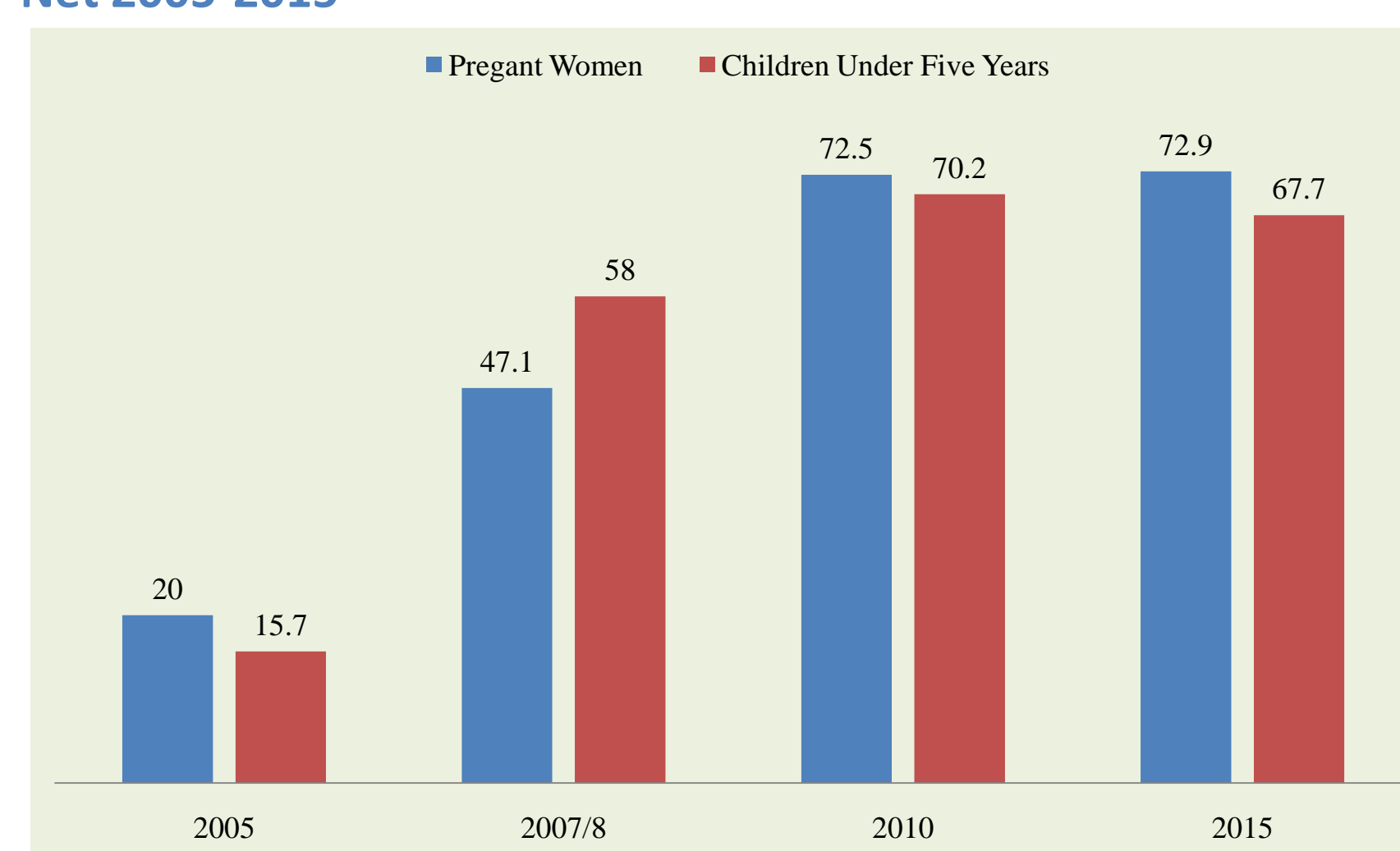

% Malaria Proportional Mortality Under 5 Years and 5 Years and Over, 2005 – 2013

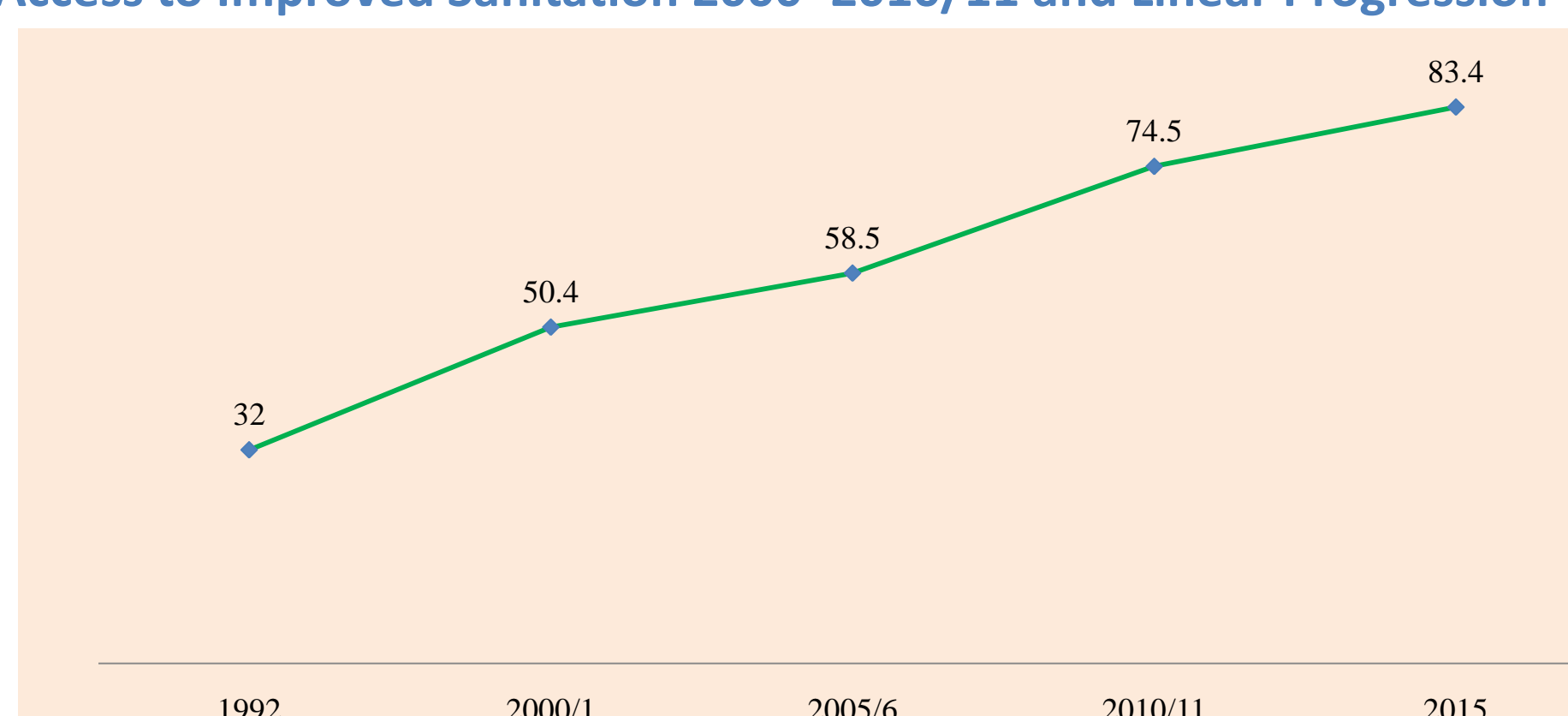
